3. The return to steam via the Indian Ocean - Overland via Marseilles

Historical overview

The initial 1857 contract with the European and Australian Royal Mail Co. was a duplication of the P&O Line service. This duplication of ships, especially across the Far East service, bankrupted the shipping line. The second contract with the P&O Line in 1859 provided a more stable and regular service. The Franco-Prussian War in late 1870 closed the route via Marseilles, with mail directed via Brindisi which continued after the war concluded in 1871.

The introduction of the French Compagnie des Messageries Maritimes Line to the Australian Colonies in the early 1880's resurrected this route, although only limited mail passed through.

A monthly service, subsidised by the French Government, was commenced by the Compagnie des Messageries Maritimes in November 1882 operating from Marseilles via Cape of Good Hope to Reunion, Mauritius, Adelaide, Melbourne, Sydney to Noumea. Generally, only Australian colonial mail addressed to France was sent via this contract.
